#### This week's reflection from Fr. Francis...

We may perhaps think that we are not like the rich man dressed in purple and linen, nor like Lazarus covered with sores. Yet we confront this reality every day. Lazarus in the parable personifies the innumerable poor and downtrodden in our society. Poverty is a stark reality of our day. The selfish abuse of wealth takes many away from God, for we can't serve both God and money. Our life is a precious gift of God, and we are responsible for the things entrusted to us. We have to use them for God's glory and for our fellowmen.

Our earthly life is the preparation for eternity. Luxury is not essential for life. We should enjoy spiritual things, but only use corporeal things. Our life becomes worthless if focused solely on worldly goods. It will have no value if centered only on the self. There is more happiness in giving than in receiving. [Acts 20:35]
