This week's reflection from Fr. Francis...

In the context of today's Gospel, all are in some way administrators. We are not masters of our own goods. Everything belongs to the Lord. Jesus clarifies that our stewardship is temporary and transitory. Our term will run out; only what is permanent is worth counting. And what remains is what we are. Hence, it will be a folly to run after perishables, to accumulate earthly goods, and neglect the eternal.

Money and possessions are God's gifts: we are not owners but only stewards, and as such, we have to render an account of all that we have. Money and possessions are good in themselves, but become dangerous if not used in accordance with God's will. The Gospel teaches us that we must take courage and do God's will in every situation. Our generosity towards the poor should find concrete expression. We should show our reliability and faithfulness in matters small as well as significant. We should balance our attitude towards wealth and positions and establish a spiritual equilibrium. God gives us time. We should not be like the barren fig tree, which needed another opportunity to be productive. [Luke 13:7]. We should use our time wisely.
