Dear parishioners St Mary's,

I am glad to make a write up about the Tamil Nadu Biblical, Catechetical and Liturgical Centre (TNBCLC), Tindivanam. South India. Archbishop Francis Kalist is the chairman and Fr John Britto is the Director of this Center.

The main apostolate of this Centre is to have periodical conventions and discussions, on bible, theology, spirituality and liturgy in the light Vatican II, conducting CCD on going formations, preparing, printing and supply the materials regarding Catholic Bible, Catechism and Liturgy in different forms and sizes for K-10 children, youth, adults and seniors and for the common use of the parish Churches, Institutions, families and individuals.

All are done in our Regional Tamil language for the Tamil speaking people all over the world like Canada, France, London, Norway, Singapore, Malaysia, Srilanka and many other countries.

This Centre conducts seminars, conferences, short term certificate courses and other week-end training classes to Priests, Religious Nuns and Laity of the State of Tamilnadu.

After covid-19 Corona, the activities of the Centre are minimized including the printing and supplying the Bibles, Catechetical books and Liturgical & prayer books basically because of the lack of funds and heavy financial constraints in maintaining the Centre. Thus one side, it has its own huge amount of debts to pay to the bible and catechism books printers. On the other side there is an increase of demand for the Bibles, catechetical books and Liturgical prayer books.

The Center is not able to get sufficient or even minimum funds from the agencies in Europe supported for long time for our projects and local contributions to do our activities at the Centre. Hence, we approach you in seeking your financial support for the regular and continued apostolates of the Centre TNBCLC through the Mission appeal.
