DIOCESE OF LA CROSSE GUIDELINES FOR REPORTING INSTANCES OF CHILD ABUSE:

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its policies and procedures, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (bishop, priest, deacon, employee, religious, vendor or volunteer). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to Mrs. Teresa Brown, Complaint Intake Agent, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Brown at 608.791.0179 or intakeagent@diolc.org. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of Safe Environment or on the diocesan website at: diolc.org/safe-environment/reporting. Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities. Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local Parish and on the diocesan website. This week's reflection from Fr. Francis...

Every Christian waits. But we do not live 'like men waiting for their master to return'. In our concrete situations, we often ignore the coming of the Lord; rather, we forget it, taking for granted that His coming is a future event on some 'last day'. Sometimes we think our waiting is in vain, our faith an empty dream. We often ignore that the readiness to meet the Lord should be an everyday concern. However, the Gospel encourages us, telling us that the kingdom of God is already yours; no one can take it away from you. God has promised, and he will fulfil it to the end.

We, on our part, are reminded to change our lifestyle. We must keep our lamps burning; our faith must shine. How? The Gospel replies: 'Sell what you have and give alms''. 'Get yourselves treasures in heaven' (LK 12:33-34). Our waiting should not discourage us, but rather make us yearn more towards the Lord. Whoever places his or her assurance on God finds so much less value in the goods of this earth. If this is true, then let us share, let us give, let us love without thought of gain unconditionally.
